Flu Vaccinations - The annual flu vaccination programme will take place in school next week, the registration link has now expired so if you still require your child to have the vaccine you may need to arrange this through your own GP.

Inhalers - As the weather turns cooler, there is more likelihood that children who suffer from asthma may have cause to use their inhaler in school. Currently, we do have a few children in school on our asthma register who we do not have inhalers and spacers for. If your child does have asthma please ensure that these are provided for school, likewise if your child is no longer being treated for asthma please ensure that school is informed so that we can remove them from our register.
