<u>Reception Play Numbers</u> - As the play is just for Reception children we do anticipate that there will not be any need for tickets. We will send a survey out next week for completion so that we can plan for the numbers attending and to make sure we remain compliant for health & safety purposes.

<u>Christmas Plays</u> - We do have a few spare tickets for both of the KS1 performances, please contact the school office. Both Reception and the KS1 plays are being recorded and copies will be available to purchase to be delivered before we close for Christmas. We do request that if you are bringing a younger child or sibling to the following performances you select a seat close to an exit, so that if they are noisy they can be quickly taken out to avoid spoiling the recording. The performances being filmed are Thursday 7th December @ the 10am Reception performance and the Thursday 14th @ the 2pm KS1 performance.

<u>Dinner Menus</u> - I would just like to explain why sometimes there may be gaps in the dinner menus visible to parents when booking. As we have a 3 week rolling cycle for menus, if we have any amendments they cannot be made whilst the menus are still live in previous weeks. For example the week of the cinema trip is the same menu as this week hence I could not make this live until this week was complete. Some food choices are available on more than one menu, again, making it difficult to amend without affecting live menus. You

will notice a comment against a couple of items (not available 15/12/23) as these are visible on other menus. I hope this makes sense, any problems please contact the office.

<u>Cinema Day</u> - as you are aware, we are taking all of the children to see **Elf on 15th December**. As we will return to school after the start of normal dinner service, the kitchen will only be offering a packed lunch box containing your child's choice of sandwich, a piece of fruit and a cake/biscuit. This can now be pre ordered via Eduspot with a **deadline to order by 1st December**. Please note there will not be any hot alternative to sandwiches on this date.

<u>Parking on Rothwell Road</u> - We have received a complaint from a resident about parking in and across the bays opposite school entrance. A parent yesterday parked across the bays, blocking a resident in for 15-20 mins before they returned to their car. Understandably, they were very annoyed and upset that someone should do this. Please can we request that parents park with consideration for our lovely neighbours who are very supportive and tolerant of the disturbance that goes with living next to the school?

<u>Uniform</u> - The uniform recycling is still available in school. Due to the weather we are not able to put it outside daily. If you wish to have a look through the uniform and it is not outside, please come to the school office at hometime preferably where posssible.
