<u>Cinema Day</u> - "Elf" on 15th December. Apologies for any confusion re dinners, we are restricted by the limits of our system as how we can operate. Just to clarify: if you would like school to provide a 'meal' for your child this will need to be pre ordered today by selecting your choice of sandwich ie. ham, cheese, tuna mayonnaise or egg mayonnaise (not 'packed lunch for trips'). If you have already ordered the "packed lunch for trips", I will speak directly with your child to ascertain their choice of sandwich. If your child normally brings a packed lunch' then no action is required and just send a packed lunch as normal. Please note there will not be any KS2 snacks (toast, teacake or fruit) on the morning of the cinema trip, any already ordered have been reimbursed, all children will get a snack box at the cinema.
