Well done to Reception who have taken the lead overall, well done on 100% attendance this week -. We fully understand genuine illness cannot be helped but it also highlights the importance of ensuring your child/ren do not miss school on other occasions such as holidays in term-time.

<u>Attendance</u> - Attendance is something that we are required to monitor closely and report on in school. Post Covid many schools, including ourselves have seen a dip in overall attendance and this is something that we are being encouraged to address. We have a new Attendance Officer at the Local Authority who is encouraging us to address poor attendance and as a last resort, imposing fines where poor attendance is not improving. Please note that any absence will have a negative impact on the overall attendance percentage and should your child be ill during the year, their attendance will run the risk of falling into the cause for concern category. Please help us to improve attendance by sending your child to school if you think they are tired or slightly under the weather and we will monitor them and send them home if they are not fit enough for school, also by avoiding booking holidays in term time. The DfE's expectation is that attendance is at a minimum of 96% which as you can see above we are not achieving, with some classes being very low.
