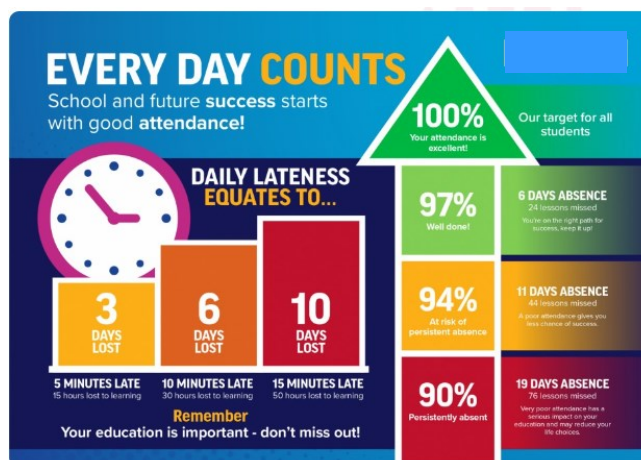
WELCOME DROP IN
