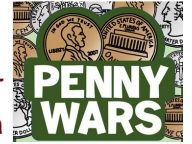
ST JOSEPH'S FEAST DAY MASS

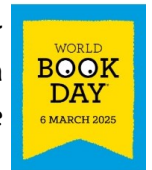
JUBILEE YEAR IF HOPE CELEBRATION MASS

PTFA MEETING

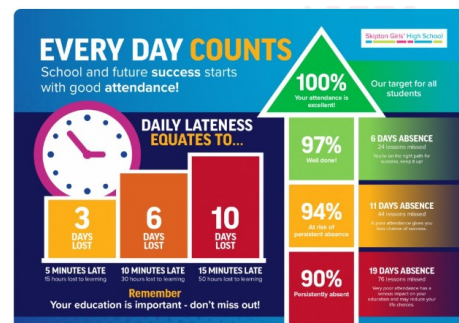
