SUPERHERO POWERS Afterschool club

At Jam Coding, our goal is to help improve children's digital skills. Children will learn to develop the illusion of superhero powers in this micro:bit Superhero Powers workshop. They will learn how to program in a new coding environment and develop their coding skills to create the illusion of a range of superhero powers, including: telepathy, mind reading, transforming, ghost busting, time travelling and teleporting! Coders will learn how to run these programs on an emulator and a real Micro:Bit computer. At the end of the course, all children will receive a certificate and one team will receive a trophy!
