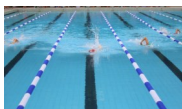
On **Monday 30th June** the Headteacher from St Joseph's Catholic High School Horwich is coming to speak to Year Five pupils and parents / carers in our school hall.

Y3/Y4 Parents/carers are invited to join us.

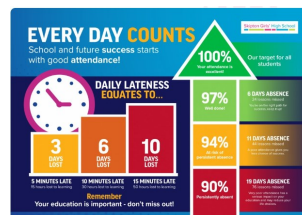

## Afterschool club\_

At Jam Coding, our goal is to help improve children's digital skills. Children will learn to develop the illusion of superhero powers in this micro:bit **Superhero Powers** workshop. They will learn how to program in a new coding environment and develop their coding skills to create the illusion of a range of superhero powers, including: telepathy, mind reading, transforming, ghost busting, time travelling and teleporting! Coders will learn how to run these programs on an emulator and a real Micro:Bit computer. At the end of the course, all children will receive a certificate and one team will receive a trophy!
