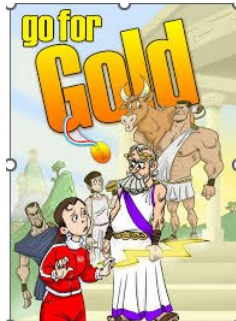

Please note we are not accepting recycled general uniform at present as we have enough stock. However, PE hoodies and PE kits are still being accepted.

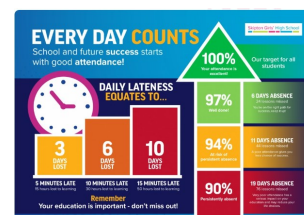
