This is how we stay safe when we use computers, mobile devices or personal phones in school:

- I will ask a teacher or suitable adult if I want to use the computers/tablets
- I will only use activities that a teacher or suitable adult has told or allowed me to use
- I will take care of the computer and other equipment
- I will ask for help from a teacher or suitable adult if I am not sure what to do or if I think I have done something wrong
- I will tell a teacher or suitable adult if I see something that upsets me on the screen
- I know that if I break the rules I might not be allowed to use a computer/tablet
- KS2 - I will only use my own log on when working on school computers/tablets
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Mobile Phones in School

- I know that I must hand my mobile phone to a member of staff when I arrive at school
- I know that school have the right to take my mobile phone if a safeguarding incident occurs involving my phone
- I know that I must not use my mobile phone whilst on the school premises/site and if I am found using it, school will take it off me and it will only be returned to a parent
